The Unión Bautista Boliviana, formed in 1936, cares for the welfare of Baptists throughout Bolivia, including our partner churches in North Potosi. The UBB provides resources for spiritual growth and supports community needs through initiatives such as the Chagas Prevention Program and Casa de la Amistad, where the prisoners in the Cochabamba jail can send their children for daycare and schooling. Leaders are trained at the UBB seminary in Cochabamba. Student life includes practical activities, like gardening for all ages. Graduates from the seminary's thirty-some student body are sought after by churches and organizations such as World Vision, Compassion, and Habitat for Humanity.
